

# Randy Royer Memorial Scholarship

The Randy Royer Memorial Scholarship recognizes a senior from Ephrata, Cocalico, Warwick, or Garden Spot High School or a son or daughter of an Ames Construction Inc. employee (at any high school) who plans to pursue a program of study related to the building/construction or automotive industry at Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology or Pennsylvania College of Technology.

Randy Royer was raised in Akron and graduated from Ephrata High School. He continued his education at Penn State University earning an Associate's Degree in Architectural Engineering Technology and a Bachelor of Science in Structural Design and Construction Engineering Technology. Randy started working for Ames Construction as a project manager and estimator immediately after college and remained there for 27 years until his sudden death in October 2016. Randy's work was his passion and was proud to be a part of the Ames Construction team.

## Scholarship Terms

This scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable award of at least \$1000.00. Actual amount will be announced when the scholarship is awarded.

## Scholarship Criteria

- At the time of application, the applicant must be a senior at Ephrata, Cocalico, Warwick, or Garden Spot High School or a son or daughter of an Ames Construction Inc. employee (attending any high school).
- The applicant must be admitted to the Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology or Pennsylvania College of Technology in in any program of study related to the building/construction or automotive industry. Please note: the scholarship check will be made out to both the student and the college.
