## Randy Royer Memorial Scholarship

#### **Scholarship Terms**

or

- b) be a high school student or recent graduate (within the last 18 months) at any high school/program <a href="mailto:and">and</a> a son or daughter of an Ames Construction Inc. employee.
- 2. The applicant must be admitted to a college/post-secondary institution for the upcoming fall semester in any program of study related to the building/construction or automotive industry. Please note: the scholarship check will be made out to both the student and the college.
